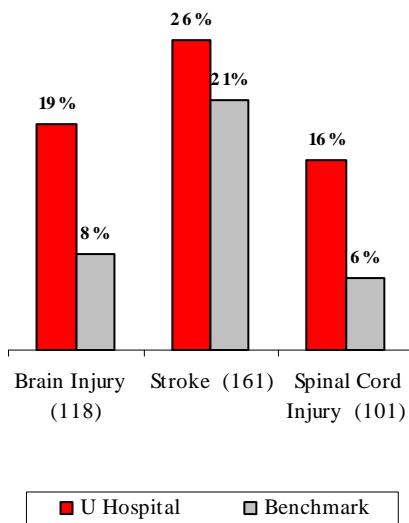
Commitment to Paving the Road to Independence

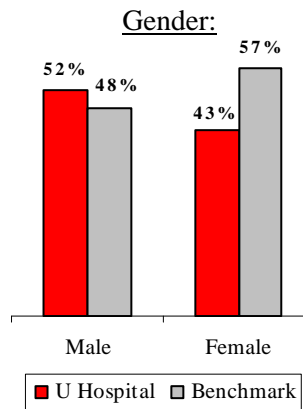

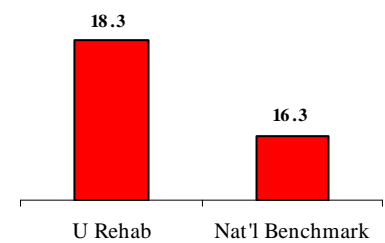

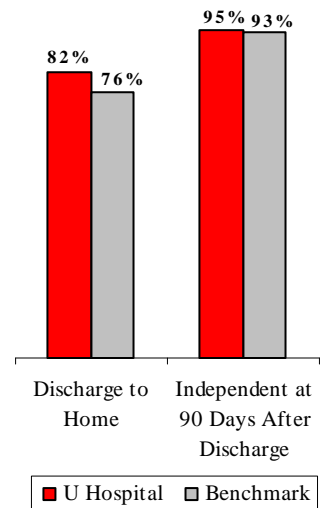
